- → We will advocate with the Government of Alberta to assist with funding that will help increase our regional non-market housing supply
- → We will advocate with the Government of Canada to assist with funding that will help increase our regional non-market housing supply
- → We will review the potential for improved interaction with Rural Municipalities Association (RMA), Alberta Municipalities (AM), Alberta Continuing Care Association (ACCA) and Alberta Seniors & Community Housing Association (ASCHA)
- → We will advocate for increasing resources and accommodations that will improve the continuing care for our region
- → We will work with post-secondaries to improve the skill base in the region to better support our growing needs

- → We will continue to explore means to fill the housing gap that the private sector is not filling

GOAL: The Grande Spirit Foundation will grow by implementing numerous improved planning approaches including asset planning, financial planning, together with partnerships and advocacy.

- → We will focus short term on affordable rental units to address the regional shortage
- → We will focus medium term on the housing needs for seniors with the number of seniors in the region increasing
- → We will look longer term to implement mixed (market and non-market) housing models, while staying true to our mission
- → We will investigate innovative ideas in home building and new implementation models that arise from time to time
- → We will investigate a variety of financial management strategies to assist in operations and growth
- → We will develop a long term asset management strategy that ensures sustainability of our assets
- → We will explore concepts for capital requisitioning

GOAL: The Grande Spirit Foundation will improve our governance and delivery of services by continuing our board and operational policy development and continuously improve our monitoring of performance through our tools of employee and resident satisfaction surveys.

- → We will explore policies regarding mixed market and non-market housing models that may be appropriate for the organization
- → We will incorporate within the financial and asset management models, the life expectancy and replacement needs of older facilities
- → We will work with the Government of Alberta to ensure capital maintenance repair requirements are incorporated into the annual business plans
- → We will explore policies regarding flexible building models with changing demographics, demands and desires to ensure the housing models are able to adapt
